When rhyming, choose interesting rhymes that aren't easily guessed. Make intentional word choices as well as line breaks. In free verse, last words of lines and how each line stops can help create music and suggest meaning.

Avoid poems
about abstractions
that are very general
(love, justice, beauty...)
unless you include details
that ground the poem so
that readers can better
visualize
your meaning.

Give details that show rather than tell so that the reader is able to make discoveries.

Create characters
that have original
characteristics and
personalities - not
simple copies of
something you have
seen elsewhere.

Choose a title that indicates the focus of your piece or reflects its meaning.
